

John Zabriskie '61 Senior Research Fellowship

The John Zabriskie '61 Undergraduate Research Fellowships were established through an endowment provided by Dr. Zabriskie in support of undergraduate research in chemistry. Dr. Zabriskie conducted undergraduate research at Dartmouth with Professor Thomas Spencer, an experience that led him to continue in chemistry as his profession. He retired as CEO of Upjohn-Pharmacia, a multinational pharmaceutical company, and passed away in March 2014.

This Fellowship provides \$2000 in financial support to cover the costs of supplies and other expenses associated with an undergraduate research project carried out by a Dartmouth senior chemistry major. The senior must have conducted two or more terms under the guidance of a member, or adjunct member, of the Dartmouth Chemistry faculty. The payment of \$2000 is transferred directly to the advisor.
